

OUR DONORS Despite difficult economic times, our donors contributed over \$380,000 to our 2014 campaign! These funds plus the time of many volunteers allows RCUW to support 32 agencies and 40 social services programs that provide assistance to thousands of Roane County residents in need. In 2014, we hope to extend our outreach through new partnerships and funding opportunities.

OUR VOLUNTEERS From the start of the year to the end, RCUW is reliant on the dedication of volunteers. At tax time VITA volunteers take the time to assist taxpayers with returns and financial counseling. Each fall, volunteers assist with our annual campaign to assure funding for community investment. In 2015, the community investment process will move to February, as volunteer panels review agency applications for the next funding year.

The Roane County United Way is a not-for-profit organization exempt from income tax under section 501c(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and provides supporting services and other assistance to public and private agencies and community organizations to meet the human service needs of the general public of Roane County. RCUW is a local autonomous organization governed by a local board of directors and operates under a charitable solicitation permit issued by the State of Tennessee.

RCUW pays annual dues of 0.138% to United Ways of Tennessee and 1% to United Way Worldwide. RCUW's cost to cover fundraising and year-round administration costs is 15% of the total amount pledged to RCUW.
